

CSR Statement - The Hunfeld

The management of Utrecht City Concepts, owner of Hotel The Hunfeld, holds Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) in high regard. Sustainability is integrated into its operations with a sharp focus on People, Profit, and Planet, as evidenced by:

- 1. Optimizing and maintaining the expertise of current staff and training new employees. CSR is emphasized during training and refresher courses.
- 2. Informing our working relationships with guests, visitors, colleagues, and suppliers about the measures we take in corporate social responsibility.
- 3. Voluntary contributions to activities such as sponsoring charities, both on an ad-hoc and permanent basis.
- 4. Continuously working to reduce CO2 emissions by reducing our energy consumption, water usage, and waste, while monitoring these factors. We also invest in energy-efficient installations and equipment.
- 5. Continuously improving our purchasing process, particularly in terms of goods and services with environmental and/or social certifications.
- 6. Purchasing environmentally friendly products and services from suppliers who have endorsed and signed our objectives.
- 7. Annually creating an CSR plan and allocating budgets for its implementation.
- 8. Conducting annual evaluations of our CSR policy and setting priorities for the next two years.

Utrecht City Concepts

Utrecht City Concepts manages several hotels in Utrecht, with The Hunfeld being one of them. During the renovation of this building, sustainable materials were consistently used. The hotel is heated using district heating, and we also use a VRF system to regulate the climate. Furthermore, we use energy-efficient lighting. The lighting and air conditioning (if desired) in the guest rooms only activate when you place the energy saver (electronic key) in the holder. When you leave the room and remove the electronic key, the lights turn off and the air conditioning stops. We also use water efficiently by providing it according to established standards, without compromising comfort. With these measures, we use energy and water very sparingly, minimize CO2 emissions, and help protect the environment.

Waste is collected separately in both public areas and guest rooms. As a guest, you can contribute by leaving your waste separated in your room. Our staff will remove the waste from the rooms, sorting it into paper and cardboard, glass, and general waste.

In the morning, we serve a delightful breakfast board with fresh products. Breakfast is only available by reservation, as we adjust the products based on the number of guests. This way, we prevent a lot of waste.

We have chosen as many local and/or organic products as possible, such as Granola and fresh free-range eggs. Some products are packaged in so-called mono packaging for hygiene reasons, including butter, sugar, and coffee cream. The mono packaging contains products that are certified with an environmental label.

Sprinkles, jam, and honey are offered in glass jars. Additionally, delicious fruit-infused water is always available in our breakfast lounge. We use Utrecht tap water, which has been rated the best-tasting water in the Netherlands, combined with delicious organic fruit or herbs, depending on the season.

In our shop, we offer beautiful souvenirs with sustainability at the forefront. These include keychains made from felled Utrecht trees and notebooks and envelopes made from old school paper and old posters.
